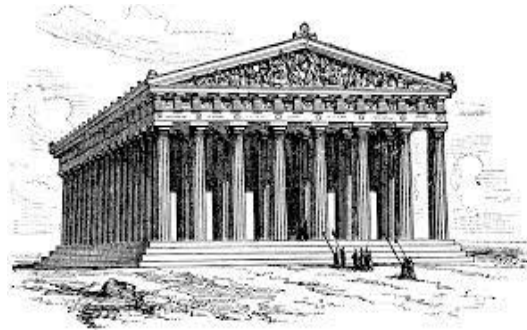


Survival Greek (12 hr course)
